

## Flashmob competition: Women's and girls' chess 2022

The German Chess Federation (DSB) and the Chess Sports Association (CSA) award prizes for the most creative activities around the topic of women's and girls' chess:

“Grab your chess boards and meet at a special place at a time of your choice. Play a few blitz games or organize some other activity related to women's and girls' chess and take some great photos and shoot some nice videos. Those should be duly published on the internet, in brochures etc. The message should be dynamic, forceful, and creative, and put women's and girls' chess in the best light”.



### Prizes

#### Germany

1<sup>st</sup> prize: 600€

2<sup>nd</sup> prize: 500€

3<sup>rd</sup> prize: 400€

#### Other countries

1<sup>st</sup> prize: 600€

2<sup>nd</sup> prize: 500€

3<sup>rd</sup> prize: 400€

For entries that do not come from Germany, a maximum of one prize will be awarded per country. The prize money for entries from Germany is provided by the DSB, the prize money for the special prizes of the special prizes from other countries by the CSA ([www.chesssport.eu](http://www.chesssport.eu)).

#### Deadline

Participation in the competition is possible by sending the material to xyz by **31.12.2022**.

#### Rights of use

By participating in the competition, the applicant allows the DSB and the CSA unlimited use of the submitted material on their websites and social media sites (including YouTube). In case you use music for your project, please make sure that you have the rights required to do so.
